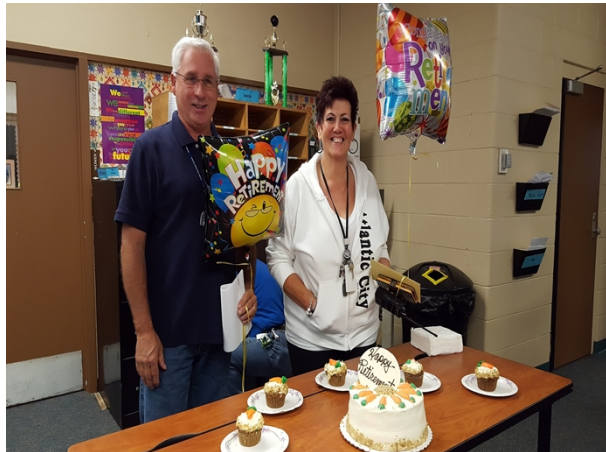





First Annual Allen Park Football Alumni Golf Classic

The Allen Park Jaguars Football Alumni is (establishing) an annual golf fundraiser. The fundraiser's purpose is to build consensus on how to best celebrate past football successes while creating (designing) a more stadium like feel at the Allen Park High School.

The field at APHS is named after Marc Egland, a player in the early 1970's, who died of testicular cancer during his senior year.

I am proposing a plan to renovate the sports complex, which is currently by football, cheerleading, band, and track and field. The plan is to gather consensus on how to go about the renovations and creating a master plan.

The plan was sparked when the leader of the football team and head football coach for many years, Mr. Ed Bellas, passed away nearly 10 years ago. Since the day of his memorial the idea to renovate the sports complex in his honor has been growing.

Coach Bellas was a beacon of pride and leadership for the many sons he coached. Players, their parents, and the community as a whole followed his lead. The founding members of the Allen Park Football Alumni want to keep his memory alive and growing. He made the football program what it was and is.

This project is not just about football, but about what sports, means to the community of Allen Park. Understandably, bond issue failed a few years back to redo the sports complex. The timing was not right as the city was under the guidance of an emergency manager due to poor fiscal management among other reasons.

My point is the Football Alumni is willing and able to start the process and carry the torch until the necessary time for the schools and city to join in. **We begin the journey this August 28, 2016 with the First Annual Allen Park Football Alumni Golf Classic.**

Players of all generations will re connect and devise a plan of action. This plan will further include input from all vested parties to obtain maximum buy in. Then a mock-up of the plans will be produced in 2D and/or 3D format to spread the idea along. The construction will be done in phases but with a necessary master plan in place.

Golfers, donations, sponsors, and volunteers have already joined this fine cause. We are asking for sponsorships of \$100 or more for each of the 18 holes at the golf event. The players are paying \$125 to attend the Football Alumni Golf Classic.
