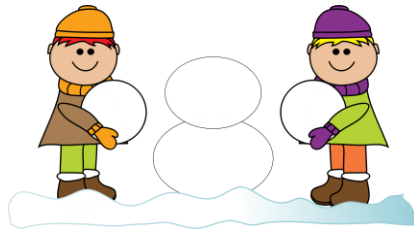
Drop Off and Pick Up... Just a Constant Reminder for the Safety of ALL our Children!

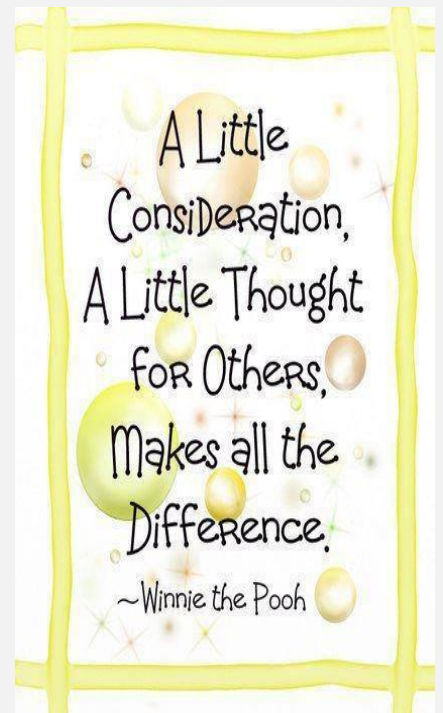
